Boys:

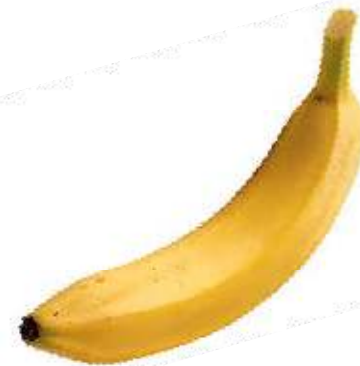
- White or black thobe with a matching fez.
